- 1) **Call Meeting to Order/Introductions:** Commissioner Shaffley called the meeting to order at 2:45 p.m.
- 2) **Description of Proposed Land Sale: Lewis County Tax Parcel Nos. 023982002016 and 023982002015:** Kyle Heaton gave a description of a proposal for a diesel exhaust fluid facility on the 4.9-acre property. He stated that the facility would include two rail spurs and tanks that would likely be used for renewable biodiesel. The area will be paved, and containment areas will be installed per Department of Ecology specifications. The new rail spurs would accommodate 3-4 rail cars per month of diesel exhaust fluid and up to 10 cars per month each of renewable biodiesel and biodiesel. The facility would also accommodate 35 truckloads per month. Approximately 25 new jobs would be created. The product would be distributed to truck stops in Washington, Oregon, and parts of Idaho.
- 3) **Public Testimony:** There was no public testimony given.
- 4) **Adjourn:** Commissioner Keahey made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 2:48 p.m. Commissioner Lahmann seconded the motion. The motion carried.
