- 1) **Call Meeting to Order/Introductions:** Commissioner Markstrom called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.
- 2) **Potential Sale of Certain Real Property:** Kyle Heaton said that the property is 2000 Northpark Drive, along with five adjacent parcels (Lewis County Tax Parcels Nos. 023922000000, 023923001000, 023923004000, 0239005000, 023923006000, and 023923007000). He said that it has a 10,000-square-foot building with an approximately four-and-a-half-acre yard with the eventual intended use for the manufacture and maintenance of shipping products, such as pallets and totes, and employing about 30 people. He added that in the meantime, the Port has identified another tenant that has been looking for an expansion. They are prepared to sign a lease and take care of the improvements. He said that in addition to the existing building, the property will have fencing and landscaped screening added as well as a gravel yard with asphalt travel lanes.

Commissioner Lahmann thanked Kyle Heaton for his work on this and said that it looks like a good deal.
