As President of the Port of Centralia Commission, I feel it is crucial to address the recent investigation into Commissioner Peter Lahmann. Additionally, we encourage Commissioner Lahmann, to participate in ethics training to ensure a clear understanding of our responsibilities and obligations.

I want to express my gratitude to the independent attorney who conducted the investigation and provided valuable insights. Their work has been instrumental in shedding light on this matter, and we appreciate their professionalism and impartiality.

Lastly, I would like to assure the community that the Port of Centralia remains committed to serving the best interests of our constituents, fostering economic growth, and maintaining the highest ethical standards.
