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Statement from Port of Centralia Commission

The Port of Centralia appreciates the Centralia City Council's decision to approve our proposal and lift the moratorium on large-scale industrial development. This action marks an important step forward for Centralia's economic future and reflects the strong partnership that has been rebuilt between the Port, the City, and Lewis County.
