RESOLUTION 2023-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF CENTRALIA, LEWIS COUNTY, WASHINGTON, EXPRESSING A COLLECTIVE POSITION IN SUPPORT OF THE APRIL 25, 2023, CENTRALIA SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 104 – PROPOSITION NO. 1: REPLACEMENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS LEVY

WHEREAS, the Centralia School District 401 has placed upon the ballot on April 25, 2023, a Replacement Levy which is necessary to maintain educational programs and operations in order to continue striving for the high academic and activities standards set by the District Board of Directors and Superintendent; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Centralia recognizes the importance of quality public schools for the vitality of our local economy, including the recruitment and retention of businesses and industries and their employees and families, and providing the skillsets and education necessary for students to earn a living wage, pursue the career goals, and productivity contribute to our community; and

WHEREAS, RCW 42.17A.55(1) permits members of an elected legislative body or by an elected board, council, or commission of a special purpose district to express a collective decision to support a ballot proposition;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF CENTRALIA AS that they endorse and support the passage of the April 25, 2023, Centralia School District No. 401 – Proposition No. 1: Replacement Educational Programs and Operations Levy.
