- 1) **Call Meeting to Order/Introductions:** Commissioner Markstrom called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.
- 2) **Approval of Agenda:** Commissioner Shaffley made a motion to approve the amended August 16, 2023, agenda as submitted. Commissioner Lahmann seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- 3) **Good of the Order/Public Comment:** Commissioner Markstrom opened the meeting to public comment and stated the rules regarding public comment.

Jan Banevich, of Centralia, commented that she has witnessed unprofessional behavior at the Port meetings over the years and asked the Commissioners to exercise their authority to reprimand whoever is at the table using inappropriate and unprofessional behavior or intimidation.

Brian Dow, of Centralia, asked if there was an update on using Zoom at Port meetings.

Cynthia Mudge, executive director of the Centralia-Chehalis Chamber of Commerce, gave an update on recent Chamber events.

- 4) **Approval of Minutes:** Commissioner Shaffley made a motion to approve the August 2, 2023, regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Lahmann seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- 5) **Approval of Warrants:** Commissioner Shaffley made a motion to approve warrants 23276 through 23301 with an aggregate amount of \$165,574.30. Commissioner Lahmann seconded the motion. The motion carried.

**6) New Business:**

**a) Executive Director Report:** Kyle Heaton gave an update on Stage 1 and Stage 2 of the Mellen Street Connector project. He said that WinCo Foods went through the site plan review committee with the City of Centralia and is currently working with the City to make final adjustments. He added that the Port continues to work on the boundary line adjustment with WinCo.

**b) Resolution No. 2023-04 Adoption of Tax Anticipation Line of Credit Notes:**

Commissioner Shaffley made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2023-04 Adoption of Tax Anticipation Line of Credit Notes with Umpqua Bank. Commissioner Lahmann seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Markstrom opened the agenda item for public comment. There was no public comment made.


